Thursday 22nd August (today) – Wellbeing Block
Friday 23rd August 10:00 until 1:00 – Sixth Form Centre

Tuesday 3th September, First Day. The first day is designed to reinforce option choices, to provide integration into new form classes and indeed into the Sixth Form in general.

Each student is to attend Registration with their new Form Tutor at 8:45. Lists of the Form Classes will be displayed in the 6th Form Centre, followed by an Induction Assembly in the Humanities Hall. Please ensure we start on the first day as we intend to continue, with no uniform issues including no jewellery (except a single pair of stud earrings).

The Induction process will continue on Wednesday 4th with lessons fully starting on Thursday 5th of September.

Moving forward, **Form registration** will take place **every Monday and Thursday**, **Mentor Periods** will be arranged with the Form Tutor and the other **compulsory element, Enrichment**, will also take place every Wednesday, lesson 5 of week B. Each student will be given a **Sixth Form Contract** outlining our expectations and requirements of a Brynteg 6th Former.
