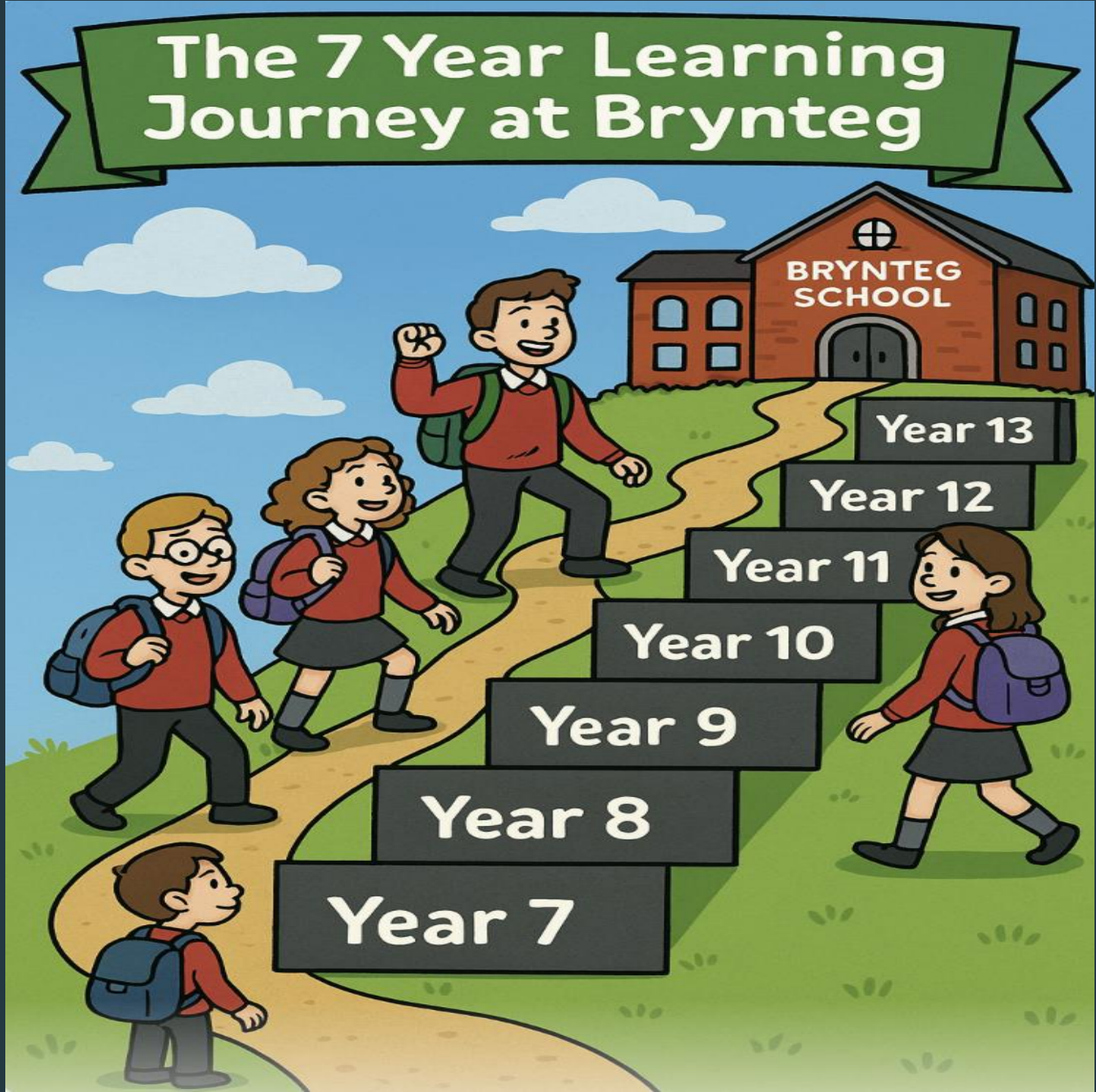

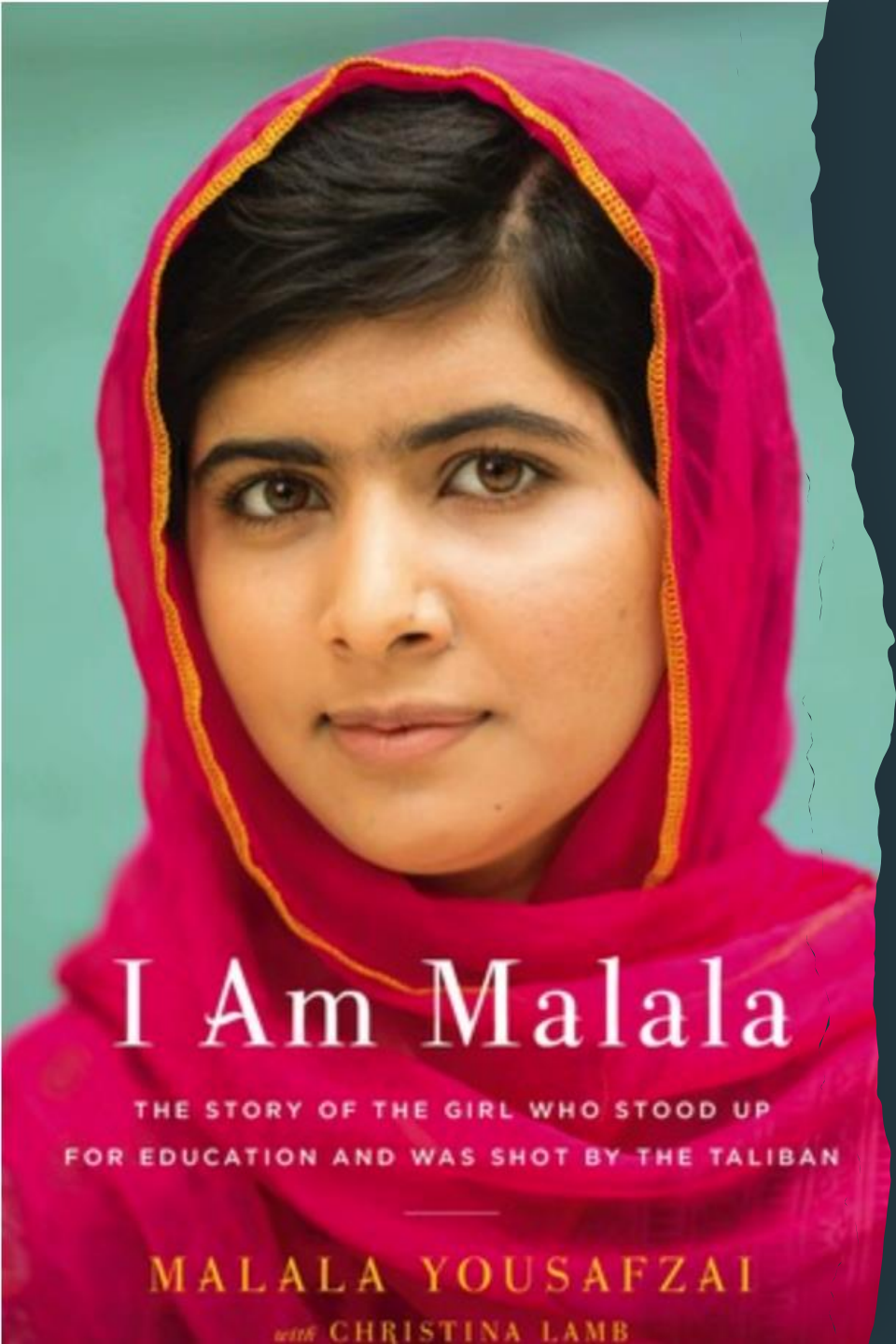

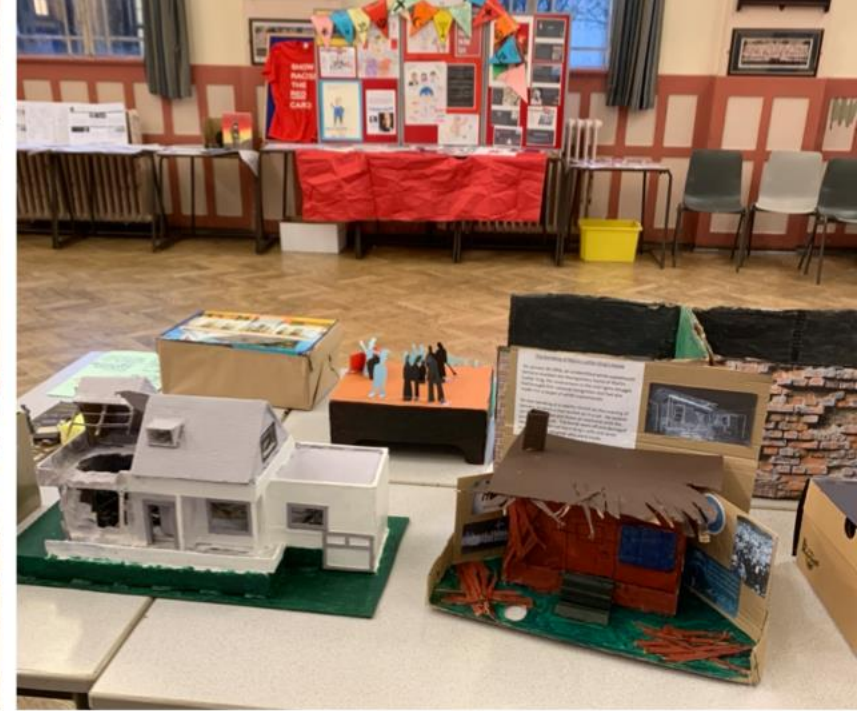

OUR DYFODOL PROVISION

The Dyfodol model at Brynteg offers pupils a full-time provision with access to secondary learning experiences.

We have 5 classes in the provision, 60 pupils in total, 5 teachers and 4 support staff.

Bag - most pupils bring a rucksack as this is easier when walking around school. The rucksack needs to be able to hold books, stationery, PE kit and so on.

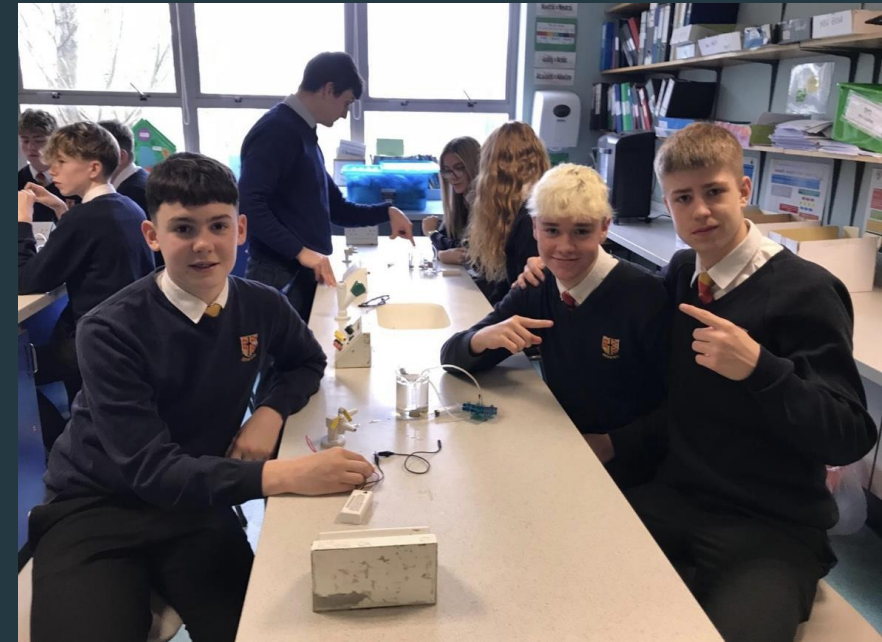
*Art packs and Maths packs will be available to purchase should you wish.



WHAT ABOUT UNIFORM?

Uniform List

- *Trousers - plain mid/dark grey - full length (to the shoe). No denim/jean type material*
- *Shirt - plain white*
- *Blazer (optional)*
- *Jumper - navy 'v' neck with school badge*
- *Tie*
- *Shoes - plain black - leather/leather effect (please note that black leather trainers are allowed as long as they are plain black). Please see the images below for examples of suitable shoes.*
- *Skirts - trousers are strongly recommended but if a skirt is to be worn it must be no more than 5cm above the knee*
- *A coat with a hood (any colour); there is lots of walking at Brynteg! 'Hoodies' are not acceptable as an outside coat and should not be worn.*
- *No leggings are permitted*
- *Dark socks are required*



SUITABLE SHOES

PE KIT



Top half: ROYAL BLUE 'Team Brynteg' T-Shirt (compulsory for all). Royal blue 'Team Brynteg' hoody (optional for outdoor activities). Reversible games shirt (compulsory for boys). Pupils can also wear a long sleeve top under their T-shirt/Games jumper in cold weather for an extra layer if it is either royal blue or black.

Bottom half: BLACK; the option of wearing black shorts, leggings, tracksuit bottoms, a skirt or shorts as long as they are an appropriate length (e.g. no short Nike pro cycling shorts). However, for gymnastics pupils can only wear black shorts or black leggings. In colder weather pupils can wear a base layer when outside, but this must be black.

Socks: Royal blue games socks or white socks.

Trainers should be sports trainers suitable for physical activity. Nike Air Force 1 version or converse shoes would be deemed unsuitable for Physical Education and a health and safety risk. Trainers/boots can be any colour.

CASHLESS CATERING SYSTEM



- Biometric system – which recognises a number of points on your son/daughter's thumb print
- We will require your permission for this before pupils start school
- You can do this by completing our pre-authorisation form
- You can easily transfer money onto your child's account using the BCBC website
- Pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals will have their accounts topped up automatically at the start of each week
- It will take a few days for this system to be up and running, and for this reason, we would suggest that you provide your child with a packed lunch for the first few days of school

HOW WILL I KNOW IF MY CHILD HAS HOMEWORK?

- Teachers will set homework for your son/daughter on 'Class Charts'.
- This is an app you and your child can download to your phone.
- During the first week in September, you will be provided with a unique code for 'Class Charts', which will enable you to see your son/daughter's timetable for each day, their attendance throughout the year, their reward and behaviour points, as well as any homework that has been set.
- Please activate your account as soon as you can - Class Charts is the system we use to communicate with you

PUPIL SUPPORT HUB & FORM TUTOR SUPPORT

The **Pupil Support Hub** is staffed throughout the day by wellbeing officers, admin staff, and a safeguarding lead. They are there to support pupils with any issues—big or small.

Pupils also see their **form tutor** every morning and again for check-out on Fridays. Form tutors are a consistent, friendly face in school, there to help your son or daughter navigate any challenges they may face.

BRYNTEG HOUSE SYSTEM

- In the first week of school, your son or daughter will be placed into a house team as part of our House System launch.
