Dear Parents and Carers,

At Brynteg, we are continuing to place a strong focus on developing pupils' independence and responsibility.

Over the coming weeks, we will be placing a greater emphasis on pupils arriving to school properly equipped and ready to learn. Having the correct equipment helps lessons start promptly, reduces disruption and encourages positive habits and organisation skills.

We would appreciate your support in ensuring pupils come to school each day with pens, pencils, a ruler, a rubber and a suitable school bag.

There will be regular equipment checks during form time. Pupils who do not have the correct equipment will receive a B1. If a pupil does not have the correct equipment on three occasions within one week, this will result in an after school reflection.

To support families, fully stocked pencil cases are available from the Hub or on ParentPay for £1, with exam pencil cases available for £2.

We would also like to remind families of our gate-to-gate phone rule. If pupils choose to bring a phone into school, it should be switched off and kept in their bag throughout the school day. Phones should not be kept in pockets, so all pupils should have a suitable school bag.

We understand there may occasionally be financial difficulties and, where needed, we will always support families sensitively and discreetly. If support is needed, please contact your child's Year Team or the Hub.
