# On Site Year 10 Subject Parent/Carer Evening – Thursday 8th February 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

The Year 10 Parent/Carer Evening is scheduled to take place **on-site** on Thursday, 8th February. The purpose of these meetings is to afford you the opportunity to schedule appointments with subject teachers and address any queries you may have.

The event will be conducted on-site, and appointments can be arranged to engage with subject teachers. The evening will run after the school day, **bookings will be open on Thursday afternoon on 1st February** and will close for bookings the day before. It is imperative that appointments adhere to the allocated time slots to facilitate other parents/carers in attending their scheduled appointments. Should you have more extensive queries requiring additional time, we can arrange a follow-up phone call. ALN will be in attendance and located in the Wellbeing block, no appointments are required for ALN.

Appointments will run from 15:45 - 18:30. Please be aware that there will be **no access** on the school site to parents/carers **before 15:40** this is due to children leaving school at the end of the school day. Please be considerate to our local residents when parking vehicles. We ask that you park any vehicles considerately.



### Dear Parent/Carer,

We know many families are currently experiencing heightened pressures, including financial. Many of you will not need to be told that the rising cost of living is increasing these pressures for households. As a school, we know an increasing number of our pupils and their families, Parents and Carers will be feeling this. With that in mind, we wanted to point you to some sources of support in areas including food and money matters. You can look into accessing it now, or in future.

Please click on these QR codes to access information on a range of support Parents/Carers and families can access. There is also a code with details of how you can support others.

**BARC – Bridgend Community Outreach Centre**. BARC offers support a range of areas, including access to food, support with fuel costs and advice around financial matters, tenancy issues and training on a number of important life skills. If you are interested in any of these, contact details are included. For support with some of the services, the school will need to be involved in terms of referring you to BARC for help. We would require a referral for the emergency food bag, no referral is needed for the £5 pantry bag. Referrals are needed for the fuel vouchers, debt help and form filling etc needed for an appointment but they do not need to be referred. The free courses do not need referrals, you can just enquire.

Our drop-in centre can only be accessed by 18 plus for safeguarding reasons, but we can support families at their home or come to the school. We can offer fuel vouchers for people that are on top up meters and are in a fuel crisis. They cannot self-refer to this scheme, the school will need to refer them.

We can do free emergency food parcels if they are referred by the school. We have a food pantry where bags of groceries can be purchased for £5, no referral is needed. We have free lunches to eat in or take away weekdays 11:30-1:30 (children must take away) We offer debt management, benefit checks and benefit claims. PIP claims. Free Adult courses which can be done at the centre or on-line at home.

Our courses are accredited CPD hours. We offer over 5000 of these so there's something in most subjects. The most popular ones are things like food hygiene and first aid. If you go on to the reed courses website we can finance anything on there.

We are happy to come and see families in the school that are struggling with finances, tenancy support, or those that would benefit from having a family support worker as early intervention in a bid to prevent problems escalating to formal intervention, we don't work directly with children but work to support the parents.
